Phase 1 Guidelines for Small Group Meetings June 2020

Before you come:

- Remind people to stay home if they have any cold, flu symptoms
- Stay home if you are COVID-19 positive
- Stay home if you are waiting on a COVID-19 test result
- Stay home for 14 days if you have been in contact with someone who has tested positive for COVID-19

When you are at church for small group:

- size of the group is 10 people or less
- meeting must take place in the downstairs fellowship area only (all areas of the building, including the kitchen, are off limits)
- social distancing - stay 6 feet away when seated and when moving through the building as best possible
- masks or face coverings are required until the individual is seated
- bathrooms should be used for emergency use only
- no food or beverages can be served or prepared, individuals can bring their own

When you arrive, there will be hand sanitizer available for you to use.

The church is responsible for the health of the congregation. While this does have an impact on our fellowship, worship, and discipleship these safeguards are in place to help us continue to do these things in the future.
